God's Word This Week: Summer Series: Apostles Creed

THE SECOND ARTICLE: BUT I STILL SIN!

As we study the Apostles' Creed, we will have the opportunity to rejoice in the Gospel message, the good news of what our Triune God has done and continues to do for us, His Church here on earth. Each section of the Creed will then highlight one of the Persons of the Holy Trinity and their ongoing work on our behalf.

Martin Luther wrote, "(Jesus) purchased and won me from sin, death and the power of the devil." But the reality is that I still sin, people still die, and satan still *prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour* (1 Peter 5:8). Ah, but forgiveness has changed it all freeing me from the guilt of my sin, changing death from the path to eternal torment to eternal joys in heaven, even allowing me to silence satan in the holy precious blood of Christ and the confident victory of His resurrection.

Stewardship Thought: Stewardship under the Cross by H.R. Curtis Stewardship is not a subcategory of Christian life; it is the Christian life. Faith and finances are inseparable. True joy is found not in storing up the things, for the things of this world won't last. True joy is found in clinging to Christ who poured out His life on the cross and now gives you His Life in His Word, Baptism, Absolution, and the Lord's Supper. The things of this world are temporarily entrusted to us by God; they are never ours. God owns all things and we will be called to account for how we manage them (Romans 14:10-12, 2 Corinthians 5:10). The Lord calls us to give cheerfully to Him a portion of what He has given to us as a demonstration of our faith and trust in Him and His provision. The cheerfulness in giving is found during and after the obedient act of giving and not necessarily before it. Your heart always goes where you put God's money.

The Second Article of the Apostles Creed

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

What does this mean?

I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary, is my Lord.

He has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, purchased and won me from all sins, from death and from the power of the devil, not with gold or silver, but with his holy, precious blood and with his innocent suffering and death.

All this he did that I should be his own, and live under him in his kingdom, and serve him in everlasting righteousness, innocence and blessedness, just as he has risen from death and lives and rules eternally. This is most certainly true.
