# St. Paul's History - Pastor Oehlert (1908-1917)

Candidate Paul Oehlert was ordained and installed during the summer of 1908. During a special meeting on March 17, 1909, the matter of purchasing a more suitable church site, as well as building a school, was considered. After a chain of meetings, it was decided on September 8, 1909, to trade the old site for four lots on the corner of Michigan Avenue and Harrison Street and erect a school on the new site as soon as possible. The building committee was composed of August Thalacker, William Radtke, Louis Simantzig, and Pastor Oehlert. On Nov. 14, 1909, the school was dedicated. From inception, the congregation, recognizing the need, had provided for a Lutheran elementary school. Since the congregation was unable to supply a teacher, various pastors assumed the responsibility of teaching.

We gave the following gifts - \$10,165.92 (\$95.76 plate); Missions - \$892.5; Improvement - \$85; Mortgage - \$1,380.30; Altar Fund - \$20; Audio/Visual - \$5; WLA Tuition Assistance - \$70; St. Paul's Student Aid - \$25 (Electronic funds included in these gifts - \$5,451.96; all offerings totaled \$12,643.72; Weekly Budgeted Target \$19,672.75). 260 souls attended worship (69, 82, 109 [18 people streamed worship]).
