#### **EPIPHANY MOMENTS:**

POPULARITY IS **NOT** PROOF OF SUCCESS

In 2009, Facebook added the "like" button. That same year, Twitter added the "retweet" feature. Interestingly, reported cases of depression began to rise sharply in 2010. It is easy to think that the more people like us, the more successful our lives must be. Likewise, it is easy to believe the more people like a church, the more successful that church is. So here is an important epiphany for both individuals and churches. Popularity is not proof of success.

Though there will be times when Christ's gospel and those who proclaim it are popular, that popularity is never the goal. Nor does that popularity define success. If a church makes its central focus things like personal improvement, healing for the sick, or social justice, that church may draw a crowd. It just fails to carry out the true agenda Christ has given his Church. The gospel of forgiveness is to be the center of all our preaching and teaching. The agenda for Christ's Church is set. It's the same agenda that was followed by the Church's Christ.

## **Budget Numbers for 2025**

The four funds of our congregation comprise the total budget of the congregation each year. They are the Current or General Fund, the largest of the four, which includes all the daily expenditures within the congregation (called workers' wages, insurance, utilities, also in this total is parsonage mortgage and our WLA commitment), Missions is our Congregations Mission Offerings or CMO given to synod each year, the Improvement Fund is designed to take care of upkeep of facilities, and our Debt Fund seeks to pay the mortgage for the church.

**General Fund:** Our Voters approved \$835,668 in 2025 which marks a 1.83% increase over last year's budget. The largest portion of this of course is compensation (\$686,410), then our WLA Commitment (\$57,408), Utilities (\$43,545), Miscellaneous [paper, Bible Studies, ] (\$30,970), Property & Other Insurance (\$15,119).

**Missions:** Our Voters approved \$39,482 for the support of our Synod and the Missions we undertake together around our globe. This is the same number that we assigned in 2024 marking neither an increase or decrease and comprises a little under 5% of our budget. When combined with our WLA support the congregation gives a little over 10% of our budget in offerings to the support of ministries outside our walls.

**Improvement Fund:** Our Voters approved \$6,000 which has been our annual amount for a number of years.

**Debt Fund (Mortgage):** After our 3 year renewal our interest rates climbed to 6.9%. This means our payments for the year come to \$156,884 or \$13,074 per month.

All totaled, our needed offerings for 2025 come to \$1,038,035 or \$86,502.92 each month. With 300 mailboxes in the congregation, this averages out at \$288.35 each month or \$3,460.12 annually, around 5% of the median household income for North Fond du Lac, WI. The individual fund breakdown would look like \$232.13 General, \$10.97 Missions, \$1.70 Improvement, & \$43.58 Mortgage each month. We know not everyone will be able to do this, others will likely be able to do much more. We only ask that you prayerfully consider the blessings God has given and what proportion to return as we thank God for all He has provided. We remain confident that He will bless it and all of us as we do so.

**Stewardship Thought** 


